

NEGOTIATED SALARY PROGRAM JOB CODES AND SUMMER SALARY IN UCPATH

NSP pay for the academic year is set up on the normal professorial job record. In addition to normal salary components [e.g., UCANNL or UCABVE, UCOFF1 (if applicable), UCDEC5 (if applicable)], you must add the UCGCYN comp rate code to record the Negotiated Salary Component and then add Job Earnings Distribution (JED), by amount. SUMMER SALARY

Summer Salary for research requires a concurrent position/job in the appropriate Research-1/9th job code as noted below. The FTE field will record the percentage of pay for summer salary and will need to be updated via PayPath each month if the total effort changes. All salary components will need to be listed (e.g. UCANNL or UCABVE, UCOFF1 (if applicable), UCDEC5 (if applicable), UCGCYN). JED will need to be created, by percent, based on the Total UC Salary (all comp rates added together) and earn code ACR. The summer research job must be terminated at the end of the summer research payment period applicable to each individual (e.g. if summer research payments end 8/31, termination would be effective 9/1). Funding for summer salary will be entered on MCOP Salary Worksheet in UCPATH. NIH caps and cap gaps are recorded in the MCOP Salary Worksheet, not on the Job.

Summer Session teaching payments will be issued as a flat-rate amount on the normal professorial job. Summer Session payments are based on the Total UC Salary in effect on 6/30.

Administrative summer salary funding (e.g., Chair ninths) will be issued based on the Base Salary amount and paid as a flat rate on the administrative job. External funding may be used to supplement the administrative 1/9th up to the Total UC Salary rate but the external funding will be added on a concurrent research job for effort reporting purposes.
