WORKLOAD POLICY

In the Department of Linguistics, instructional workload credit (IWC) and appointment percentages are derived directly from the academic units assigned to a course, unless otherwise noted. A 4-unit course is considered the standard basis for the IWC and level of efforts calculations:

IWC by Course unit

- 2-unit Course = .5 course = 17% appointment
- 4-unit Course = 1 course = 33% appointment
- 6-unit Courses = 1.5 course = 50% appointment

IWC by Course enrollment

- Course with enrollment of 199 or less = 1 course= 33% appointment
- Course with enrollment of 200 or more = 1.5 course= 50% appointment

IWC by Responsibilities

- LIGN 139 Field Methods (4-unit course) =50% appointment due to additional course preparation activities including identification and coordination of language consultant and 4 hours of elicitation sessions per week outside of the classroom.

The following IWC structure is applicable to a 4-unit course

- 9 courses per year = 100% for the year
- Course with enrollment of 199 or less in a given quarter = 1 course (33%)
- Course with enrollments of 200 or more in a given quarter = 1.5 courses (50%)
